SHOTBLASTING

Shotblasting is often used to remove dirt, grease, rust or previous coating from metal. It is an effective method of stripping steel parts to the bare metal.

It is the perfect preparatory operation for achieving the best surface adhesion for whatever new coating you intend to apply.

Shotblasting is a process in which an abrasive material is forced through a jet nozzle using compressed air pressure.



We shotblast old steel gates, machinery, furniture, trailers, tractors, bikes, wheels, etc.

Sand blasting the surface of your material prior to coating provides an excellent surface for the powder coating or painted finish to adhere to. It also increases the adhesion and durability of the finish.

POWDER COATING

Powder coating creates a professional looking finish on steel and most metals.

The process works by spraying electrostatically charged particles of powder paint onto the metal surface. These powder paint particles are later cured on in an oven where they melt and coalesce to form a continuous film or 'skin' to create a smooth, long-lasting finish.



The powder coating process is better than spray paint or any other similar methods of painting a metallic surface. It ensures maximum durability for your steel components

When applied to a galvanised substrate, a powder coated finish offers a long lasting, low-maintenance and colourful covering, ideal for architectural metalwork, street furniture, fencing and gates as well any other steel products.
